WORLD FOCUS

GENERAL

From an article written by Dr Patrick Sookhdeo....

Christians, as a persecuted minority, have a choice - capitulate or remain at odds with the prevailing culture. Christians must remember five things:

- 1. Respond with grace. Without Christ we are no less sinful and no more discerning than anybody else.
- 2. Beware of taking sides in a Western culture war. The errors of the Left should not push us carelessly to embrace the values of the political Right, or vice-versa.
- 3. Before we rush to criticise governments and cultures across the world, we need to remember the fallacious nonsense prevalent in own culture.
- 4. Be prepared to sacrifice possessions, money, safety and even our lives for the cause of Christ as our brothers and sisters are called to do around the world. Have we forgotten that Christians are called to take up their cross daily (Luke 9:23)? Are we in danger of being conformed to this world (Romans 12:2)?
- 5. While the Western world might be slipping away from Christian influence, it is not our home. "Here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come" (Hebrews 13:14, ESV). The Church in the West, and across the world, may decline or even disappear yet the Kingdom of Christ will continue, and all the world will be brought under His authority and rule.
