#### **WORLD FOCUS**

#### **PAKISTAN**

Pastor Zafar Bhatti, founder of the Jesus World Mission Church, was arrested in July 2012, aged 49, after a Muslim cleric falsely accused him of sending text messages defaming the mother of Mohammed. He was tortured in custody to extract a confession but he always insisted on his innocence. Zafar eventually came to trial in 2017, with proceedings being conducted inside prison because of security threats, and was sentenced to life im-

prisonment for supposedly insulting Mohammed. In December 2021, this was increased to the death penalty. He suffered various health problems whilst imprisoned, including diabetes and heart disease, and at least 47 appeals for bail on health grounds were cancelled. While in prison Zafar experienced much violence from other prisoners. His wife Nawab struggled to make ends meet after her husband's arrest despite much needed help.

On October 2nd this year, aged 62, his conviction was finally overturned by the Lahore High Court. But sadly, he passed away three days later, on 5th October, at his home in Rawalpindi. He fought the good fight and will be rewarded in eternity by his Saviour. Pictures below at age 49 and 62.
