PERSECUTION TRENDS FOR 2026 part 2

IRAN Christians directly involved in ministry were a particular target for the authorities in 2025. Persecution is increasing because the authorities are aware of the growth in the number of converts and house churches and are determined to stem this. Their goal is to exterminate the Persian-speaking church and allow only the Christian-minority groups to operate. Longer prison sentences are being given to Christian workers. Converts and especially leaders and ministry workers are likely to face increasing pressure in 2026.

IRAQ The Kurdistan region of Iraq has become a refuge for persecuted Christians including Muslim-background believers (MBBs) fleeing violence, discrimination and threats from across Iraq and beyond. In southern and central Iraq persecution remained severe in 2025, especially for MBBs. Evangelism and conversion from Islam are considered crimes under Iraqi law.

AFGHANISTAN Christians face threats from the Taliban, local devout Islamic leaders and from families. Persecution is increasing. It is expected that in 2026 Christian families, who have to practise their faith in secret, will continue to be hindered in raising their children according to their beliefs, plus more arrests and imprisonments in 2026 and more Christians to be forced from their homes.
