Tamara in Moldova and the Swartz Family in Princeton USA

At this time of year, we often send a gift to Tamara Bucur in Moldova. Since 1996 she has started a church in her village that has a special focus on preaching the Gospel and sharing it in action through helping the elderly and children. She has facilitated building a church centre, and also cares for 9 children who are orphaned. WORLD FOCUS

NIGERIA & MOZAMBIQUE

Q. Why is there so much bad news about these countries?

A. Because the Islamic terrorists are particularly targeting Christians and seeking to impose Islam across the northern and increasingly middle Africa.

Nigeria - 303 pupils and 12 teachers were abducted from a Christian boarding school in Niger State. Fifty of the pupils have since escaped. This is similar to the kidnapping of 276 girls from a boarding school in April 2014 by Islamist extremists. Around 160 of those girls have subsequently escaped, been rescued or released.

Nigeria - Thirty-eight Christians were abducted by Fulani Islamist extremists who attacked Christ Apostolic Church, Eruku, on 18 November, killing three of the congregation. Those abducted have since been rescued by the security forces.

Mozambique - At least 22 Christians have been killed in the past month by Islamic State Mozambique (IS-M), which has been waging an insurgency in the region since 2017. IS-M have killed more than 1,800 Christians since 2017.

Pray:- Ask the Lord to intervene to protect His people. Pray that there will be peace for all people in the region, especially vulnerable Christians. Give thanks for the rescue of the 38 worshippers and ask that they will recover swiftly from the trauma of their ordeal. Pray that the 250+ abducted Christian schoolchildren and teachers will escape or be rescued and reunited with their families soon.
