CHINA'S digital surveillance – part 2

Last week we read about the increasing physical and online surveillance in China. This week we will look at an example.

Ming (pretend name) first heard about Jesus while he was away at college and became a Christian. His father reported him to the police and he was then confined to his home and prevented from attending school in their area. Ming relocated to where there were fewer restrictions and he was able to go to church. He married and had a daughter. Then God spoke to him to return to his hometown. He had to leave his wife and daughter, due to pressure from his father-in-law. He started smuggling Bibles and leading small groups in worship and Bible study. This entailed great insecurity, isolation, and vigilance. Ming is strong in faith, but he has been mentally exhausted in the work. Nevertheless, at the risk of his own life and freedom, he keeps sharing God's Word. Life for courageous believers like Ming is likely to get harder.

Pray:- 2 Timothy 1:6-8 - I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands. For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline. So do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord or of me his prisoner. Rather, join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God.
